- Re-use and repeat as many times as you like to as many groups as you like. Now you can't do that with a ordinary chocolate bar!!!!

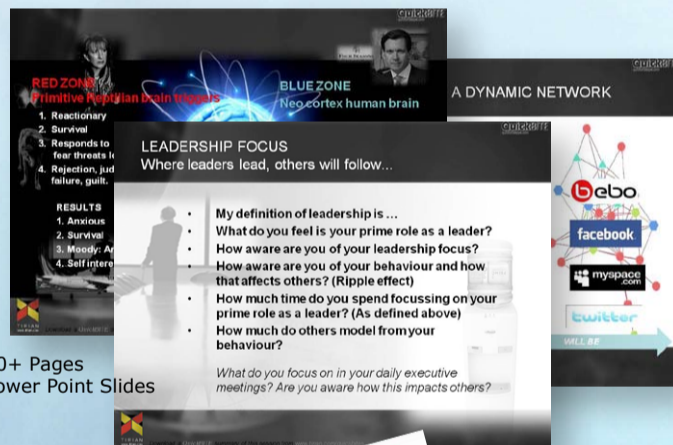

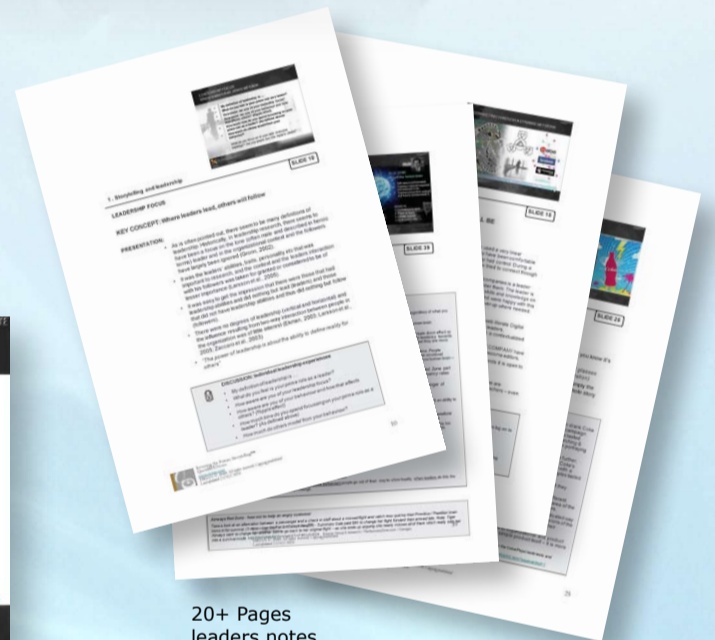

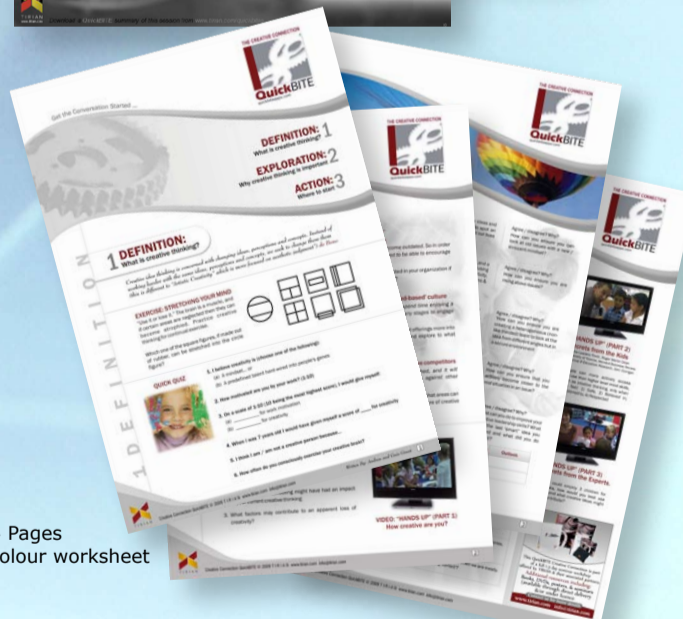
